Grape Varietals 100% Chardonnay **ABV** 13.5%

Soil Type Clay & Limestone

## Vinification

Fermented in open wooden vats with temperature control, then aged in oak barrels (30% new oak) for 20 months.

## History

The Thenard family has owned land in Givry since 1760, but the estate was not officially founded until 1842. Thirty years later, in 1872, Baron Paul Thenard acquired two large parcels in Le Montrachet, totalling 1.86 hectares. This transaction put the domaine on the map making the Thenards the 2<sup>nd</sup> largest landholder in Montrachet behind only the Marquis de Laguiche, with their single parcel of 2.06 hectares. Additional vineyard acquisitions in the 20<sup>th</sup> century of the grand cru vineyards Clos du Roi in Corton and Les Grands Echezeaux in Flagey made Thenard one of the most important estates in Burgundy. The heart of the domaine remains in the humble village of Givry, and has been under the direction of Baron Jean-Baptiste Bordeaux-Montrieux since the early 1980's.

## **Tasting Notes**

A very classic expression of Burgundy.

Day bright colour, yeastiness character on the nose, white flours, minerals. Creamy on the palate, great elegance, long lasting finish.
